The plan has been prepared by Framlingham Town Council following extensive consultation with the local community.

**Regulatory Requirements**

In accordance with Regulation 15 of the above Regulations, Framlingham Town Council as a qualifying body has submitted to Suffolk Coastal District Council:

- A copy of the plan proposal (including a map of the area to which the plan relates);
- A consultation statement;
- A basic conditions statement; and
- A Sustainability Appraisal and Habitats Regulation Assessment

Suffolk Coastal is now required (Regulation 16) to publicise details of the plan proposal and invite comment ahead of the submission of the plan to independent examination.
